

Payment: Credit Cards (Visa, Master Card, American Express, & Discover), Checks, and Cash will be accepted.

All Options MUST be paid in CASH. No CHECK'S or CREDIT CARDS on Options.

Target Fees & Taxes: ALL NSCA & GSCA fees and taxes are built into the price of each event.

Refunds: No refunds of deposits or prepaid entry fees after April 1st, 2020, except for emergency. A written request must be submitted. All entries are final. After April 1st, 2020, except for emergencies, entry fees will not be refunded. Shoot management will consider emergency medical withdraws accompanied by a written request. No refunds due to inclement weather conditions.

Eligibility: All participants must be a current member of the NSCA. New membership applications will be accepted at the shoot upon registering. Per I.R.S. regulations; shooters whose cash awards total \$600.00 or more must provide their S.S.N. on a completed W-9 before payouts can be made to the shooter by July 1st, 2020 or all winnings will be forfeited. W-9's will be available at the registration desks. 300 registered targets must be shot in 2020 or shooter must shoot penalty class in all events.

Rules & Regulations: All NSCA rules apply. FITASC rules apply in all FITASC events.

Protests & Corrections: Protests must be submitted in writing with a \$100.00 deposit fee, to shoot management by 5:00 pm or 15 minutes after last shot fired on the day the event was shot. All protests must be made in accordance with NSCA or FITASC rules and will be decided by the Protest Committee whose decision is final.

Security: Security will be provided on property from 7pm - 7am daily



Rule, Regulations & Protest - All NSCA & FITASC rules apply.

All protest must be submitted in writing and submitted to the protest committee member. Protest committee members will be posted on the score board at the Pavilion by Wednesday, June 17, 2020. The deadline for submitting a protest is 5:00 pm or 15 minutes after the last shot is fired on the day the incident took place. Protests must be submitted in writing with a \$100.00 protest deposit fee with shoot management. All protests must be made in accordance with NSCA or FITASC rules and will be decided by the Protest Committee whose decision is final. In the event the protest committee rules in the favor of the competitor, the protest deposit fee will be returned. If the protest is not upheld, the protest deposit will be forfeited to a charity of shoot management's choice. The decisions of the protest committee an management are final. - No reloads allowed in any event.

Behavior - Meadows Gun Club and Shooting School will not tolerate any alcohol use prior to/during any shooting events. Excessive alcohol use or abnormal behavior will not be tolerated. Excessive profanity is not permitted on any and all shooting grounds, vendor area, Pro-Shop, Registration, and parking area. Anyone not abiding by these restrictions will be asked to exit/leave Meadows Gun Club and Shooting School. Meadows Gun Club and Shooting School and shoot management also have the right to refuse entry or withdraw any contestant who annoys, endangers, or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot.

Responsibility - It is the shooters responsibility to declare concurrent and proper class. Please check your shooter receipt to make sure you have been placed in the proper class/concurrent, and any options played. The shooter is responsible in verifying that their scores are correct before leaving each station. Scores can NOT be changed once the shooter has departed the station. Any corrections that need to be made to score and/ or events must be reported to registration staff as soon as possible. We recommend shooters check their scores each day, prior to beginning of the shoot-offs on the day of each event.

Safety - Eye and ear protection is a mandatory requirement for all participants, spectators, trappers, referees, and staff during all times while on the course(s), games, shoot-offs, entertainment, and/or practice areas. Anyone not abiding by these rules will be asked to exit the shooting grounds and Meadows Gun Club and Shooting School property.
